\$1,020,000 In 2019 we launched a Rebuilding Capital CAMPaign! We fundraised **Total Raised** for what insurance, Fema and The City of Berkeley would not cover. This includes: \$820,000 * main camp shade structures Campers & Staffers * tall trees (more than 1 ft) * 3000 plants and trees (needed \$200,000 to replant 22 acres of camp) **FOBTC** * trail reconstruction and maintenance



\$420K - 2 Shade Structures - the design and construction of engineered structures in main camp over the green chair circle, and the playground.

\$110K - Nature - 3000 plants including tall trees, nursery care, planting plan, actual planting.

\$50K - City of Berkeley - to show community support prior to Council Vote on whether to rebuild (2017).

\$115K - Campaign Expenses - other ongoing campaign expenses over the last 3 years.
